Contaminated Blood Petition – this petition is currently active and concerns the urgent and swift response to the recent Archer Report and its recommendations into how the Haemophiliac community were given contaminated blood and blood products in the 1980's. Of the many recommendations from the Archer Report there is one for compensation to those within the Haemophiliac community that have been infected with HIV/AIDS and Hepatitis C. Recently 4,127 Haemophiliacs have received letters informing them that they have been exposed to vCJD. So far, there have been almost 2,000 deaths within the Haemophilia community.
